Please find attached the New Cub Scout Pack Overnighter Site Approval Form. **ALL** Cub Scout Overnighters must be held at a facility on the new Central Florida Council approved pack overnighter list. The process is simple and easy just complete **step 1 & 2** and we will do the rest.

Pack Overnighter Site Approval Form Process

1. **Check approved site list for your location. If not listed, complete step 2**
2. **Send the completed Pack Overnighter site approval form via email, mail or at any district meeting to District Camping / Outdoor Chairman by any BSA registered leader.**
3. District Camping / Outdoor Chairman reviews form for approval and submission to council.
4. District Camping / Outdoor Chairman uses 2007 National Standards form to review possible accredited recreational family camp or council organized camp
 - Accredited recreational family camp - All standards marked with an asterisk (*) apply
 - Council - District organized camp - All standards marked with an M apply
5. All forms signed and submitted to council camping committee advisor.
6. Approved sites added to the council camping location list.
