What is the National Jamboree?

Every four years, the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America organizes the ultimate Boy Scout Experience, the National Jamboree! In 2005, over 40,000 Scouts and Scouters attended the Jamboree. Activities include: rifle shooting, bikathlons, scuba diving, fishing, trapshooting, canoe slalom, rappelling towers, pioneering, Action Alley, kayaking, 4-way volleyball, Buckskin Games, a huge merit badge midway, daily stage shows, the Order of the Arrow American Indian Village, and much, much more!

Qualifications - This information is from the National Jamboree Division.

Boy Scouts and Varsity Scouts must be at least First Class Scouts. They must have completed the sixth grade or be at least 12 years of age by July 1, 2010, but not have reached their 18th birthday by August 4, 2010. All Boy Scouts and Varsity Scouts must participate in a pre-jamboree training experiences; file a complete Personal Health and Medical Record, No. 67-34412, prior to the pre-jamboree training; have been active in a troop or team for at least six months prior to July 1, 2010; and be approved by the unit leader and local council.

Cost

The cost of the 2010 National Scout Jamboree is \$1,745. Every effort was made to make the fee as low a price as possible, while preserving the quality of the Jamboree experience. This will cover the National Jamboree fee, travel and tour expenses, meals, lodging, troop equipment, accident and sickness insurance, troop numbers, patrol medallions, and the cost of pre-jamboree training. The Council Contingent will be visiting the National Whitewater Center in Charlotte, NC as a side trip.

Application

The National office requires parents to register their son's through their (the parent) MyScouting account. The \$100 deposit and half the total fees (\$825) must be paid in order to be placed upon the Jamboree council contingent list. **Please note that all final payments are due April 1st**
